All classroom teachers will provide and review a course syllabus with each class. The course syllabus is to include: units, curriculum aligned activities and grading practices.

## Retesting

Students who demonstrated effort and have not met expectations may have the opportunity to retake a summative assessment with the following stipulations:

- it must be during the marking period after the due date and before the NEXT summative assessment.
- retesting will be done at a time mutually agreed upon by the student and the teacher.
- the student can earn a maximum of $80 \%$ on the retake, the highest of the two scores will go on record.
- retests will not be given for final/end-of-year exams.

If a student receives a grade below $60 \%$ in a state assessed course
(Government, Algebra I, and ELA 10) but receives a passing score on the state assessment the student is then eligible to earn a $60 \%$ in the related course.
