

Electronics Policy
2017-2018

1. All electronic devices must be out of sight and on silent mode by the 7:50AM bell, including cell phones, headphones, mp3 players, etc.
2. Students are not permitted to use electronic devices during class transitions or during class periods.
 - a. Students are permitted to use electronic devices in the classroom ONLY if a structured lesson establishes a need for electronic use and permission has been granted by the classroom teacher.
 - i. In that event, electronic devices are permitted to be used for educational purposes with criteria established by the classroom teacher.
 - ii. Failure to adhere to the criteria established by the classroom teacher and lesson will be a violation of the electronics policy and result in disciplinary action.
3. Students are permitted to use electronic devices while seated in the cafeteria during their assigned lunch period.
 - a. Devices must be used while seated, and audio from devices should not be audible to others.
4. Students must adhere to the county electronic use policy at all times, and are not permitted to video record or photograph inappropriate situations, such as recording confrontations.
5. Cell phone audio recording is not permissible without that individuals prior consent.
