- 1. All electronic devices must be out of sight and on silent mode by the 7:50AM bell, including cell phones, headphones, mp3 players, etc.
- 2. Students are not permitted to use electronic devices during class transitions or during class periods.
  - a. Students are permitted to use electronic devices in the classroom ONLY if a structured lesson establishes a need for electronic use and permission has been granted by the classroom teacher.
    - i. In that event, electronic devices are permitted to be used for educational purposes with criteria established by the classroom teacher.
    - ii. Failure to adhere to the criteria established by the classroom teacher and lesson will be a violation of the electronics policy and result in disciplinary action.
- 3. Students are permitted to use electronic devices while seated in the cafeteria during their assigned lunch period.
  - a. Devices must be used while seated, and audio from devices should not be audible to others.
- 4. Students must adhere to the county electronic use policy at all times, and are not permitted to video record or photograph inappropriate situations, such as recording confrontations.
- 5. Cell phone audio recording is not permissible without that individuals prior consent.
